## CHAPTER 266, Laws of 1979

AN ACT to amend 300.02 (2) (a) (intro.) of the statutes, relating to citation forms for municipal court.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 300.02 (2) (a) (intro.) of the statutes, as affected by chapter .... (Assembly Bill 16), laws of 1979, is amended to read:

300.02 (2) (a) (intro.) The citation shall be signed by a peace officer or endorsed by a municipal attorney or, if applicable, signed by a conservation warden. In cities of the 1st class, the city, by ordinance or resolution, may authorize additional city employes to sign the citation with respect to ordinances which are directly related to the official responsibilities of the employes addition, the governing body of a municipality authorized to adopt the use of citations may designate by ordinance or resolution other municipal officials who may issue citations with respect to ordinances which are directly related to the officials who may issue citations with respect to ordinances which are directly related to the officials who may issue citations with respect to ordinances which are directly related to the official responsibilities of the officials.
