CHAPTER 295, Laws of 1979

AN ACT to repeal 48.53 (2); to renumber 48.53 (1); and to amend 48.355 of the statutes, relating to duration of dispositional orders for children adjudged delinquent whose legal custody has been transferred to the department of health and social services.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 48.355 (4) of the statutes is amended to read:

48.355 (4) TERMINATION OF ORDERS. All orders under this section shall terminate at the end of one year unless the judge specifies a shorter period of time. Extensions or revisions shall terminate at the end of one year unless the judge specifies a shorter period of time. No extension under s. 48.365 of an original dispositional order may be granted for a child whose legal custody has been transferred to the department under s. 48.34 (4m) if the child is 18 years of age or older when the original dispositional order terminates. Any order made before the child reaches the age of majority shall be effective for a time up to one year after its entry unless the judge specifies a shorter period of time.

SECTION 1m. 48.53 (1) of the statutes is renumbered 48.53.

SECTION 2. 48.53 (2) of the statutes is repealed.

SECTION 3. Effective date. This bill takes effect on July 1, 1981.
