## **CHAPTER 296, Laws of 1979**

AN ACT to renumber 30.80 (3); and to create 30.80 (3) of the statutes, relating to increasing the penalty for violating the boat toilet law.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 30.80 (3) of the statutes is renumbered 30.80 (4).

SECTION 2. 30.80 (3) of the statutes is created to read:

30.80 (3) Any person violating s. 30.71 or any rule promulgated under that section shall forfeit not more than \$100 for the first offense and shall forfeit not more than \$200 upon conviction of the same offense a 2nd or subsequent time within one year.

SECTION 3. Cross-reference changes. In the sections of the statutes listed in Column A, the cross-references shown in Column B are changed to the cross-references shown in Column C:
