CHAPTER 30, Laws of 1979

AN ACT to repeal 940.20 (1) (b); and to renumber and amend 940.20 (1) (a) of the statutes, relating to battery by prisoners.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 940.20 (1) (a) of the statutes is renumbered 940.20 (1) and amended to read:

940.20 (1) Any prisoner confined to a state prison or other state, county or municipal detention facility who intentionally causes bodily harm to an officer, employe, visitor or another inmate of such prison or institution, without his or her consent, is guilty of a Class $\underline{E} \underline{D}$ felony.

SECTION 2. 940.20 (1) (b) of the statutes is repealed.
