## CHAPTER 304, Laws of 1979

AN ACT to amend 15.405 (6) of the statutes, relating to adding a dental hygienist to the dentistry examining board.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 15.405 (6) of the statutes is amended to read:

CHAPTER 304 1508

15.405 (6) Dentistry examining board. There is created a dentistry examining board in the department of regulation and licensing. The dentistry examining board shall consist of 6 7 members appointed for staggered 5-year terms. Five of the members shall be licensed dentists in this state. One member shall be a dental hygienist certified to practice in this state who shall have all the powers and duties of public members under s. 15.08 (1m) except that the dental hygienist member may participate in the preparation and grading of licensing examinations for dental hygienists. One member shall be a public member. No person shall may be appointed to the examining board who is in any way connected with or has a financial interest in any dental or dental hygiene school or department. The secretary may receive such compensation, in lieu of a per diem, as the examining board directs.
