CHAPTER 31, Laws of 1979

AN ACT to amend 971.09 (1) of the statutes, relating to a plea of guilty for crimes committed in several counties.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 971.09 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

971.09 (1) Any person who admits that he <u>or she</u> has committed felonies or violations of s. 943.24, or both, <u>crimes</u> in the county in which he <u>or she</u> is in custody and also in another county in this state, may apply to the district attorney of the county in which he <u>or she</u> is in custody to be charged with those crimes so that he <u>the person</u> may plead guilty and be sentenced for them in the county of custody. description of all admitted crimes and the name of the county in which each was committed.
