AN ACT to amend 348.27 (10) of the statutes, relating to the transportation of loads of coal within 5 miles of the Michigan-Wisconsin border.

CHAPTER 315, Laws of 1979

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 348.27 (10) of the statutes, as created by chapter 34, laws of 1979, is amended to read:

348.27 (10) Transportation of coal on a vehicle of loads of coal exceeding or a combination of 2 or more vehicles which exceed statutory weight or length limitations and for the return of the empty vehicle or vehicles which exceed statutory weight length limitations over any class of highway for a distance not to exceed 5 miles from the Michigan-Wisconsin state line. If the roads desired to be used by the applicant involve streets or highways other than those within the state trunk highway system, the application shall be accompanied by a written statement of route approval by the officer in charge of maintenance of the other highway.
