## CHAPTER 332, Laws of 1979

AN ACT to create 908.07 and 970.03 (11) of the statutes, relating to allowing hearsay testimony at preliminary examinations.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 908.07 of the statutes is created to read:

908.07 Preliminary examination; hearsay allowable. A statement which is hearsay, and which is not otherwise excluded from the hearsay rule under ss. 908.02 to 908.045, may be allowed in a preliminary examination as specified in s. 970.03 (11).

SECTION 2. 970.03 (11) of the statutes is created to read:

970.03 (11) The court may admit a statement which is hearsay and which is not excluded from the hearsay rule under ss. 908.02 to 908.045 to prove ownership of property or lack of consent to entry to or possession or destruction of property.
