## CHAPTER 73, Laws of 1979

AN ACT to renumber 632.05; and to create 632.05 (2) of the statutes, relating to measurement of loss for property insurance.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 632.05 of the statutes is renumbered 632.05 (1).

SECTION 2. 632.05 (2) of the statutes is created to read:

632.05 (2) TOTAL LOSS. Whenever any policy insures real property which is owned and occupied by the insured as a dwelling and the property is wholly destroyed, without criminal fault on the part of the insured or the insured's assigns, the amount of the loss shall be taken conclusively to be the policy limits of the policy insuring the property.
