CHAPTER 76, Laws of 1979

AN ACT to amend 349.12 of the statutes, relating to the authority to designate no-passing zones.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 349.12 of the statutes is amended to read:

349.12 Authority to designate no-passing zones. The department with respect to the state trunk highway system and each, county highway committee with respect committees and local authorities, in regard to highways under its jurisdiction their respective jurisdictions, may determine, in accordance with standards and procedures adopted by the department, where overtaking or passing or driving to the left of the center of the roadway would be especially hazardous and may, by appropriate signs approved by the department or by a yellow unbroken line on the pavement on the right hand right-hand side of and adjacent to the center line or a lane line of a roadway, indicate the beginning and end of such zones.
