CHAPTER 83, Laws of 1979

AN ACT to appropriate \$3,022 from the general fund for payment of a claim made by Roman and Santina Worzalla against the state.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Claim against the state. There is appropriated \$3,022 from the general fund to Roman and Santina Worzalla, Brookfield, Wisconsin, as reimbursement for funeral expenses incurred as the result of the death of their son, Donald, at the central state hospital on November 24, 1974. Donald Worzalla was found dead in a storeroom at the hospital as the result of self-inflicted injuries. Acceptance of this payment operates as a full and complete release to the state and its officers and employes for any liability in connection with the death of Donald Worzalla.
