CHAPTER 85, Laws of 1979

AN ACT relating to the refund of watchmaker registration fees.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Refund of watchmaker registration fees. From the appropriation under section 20.165 (2) (g) of the statutes, as affected by chapter 34, laws of 1979, the department of regulation and licensing is directed to refund to all watchmakers and apprentice watchmakers holding registration certificates valid on July 28, 1979, the watchmaker and apprentice watchmaker registration fees paid to the watchmaking examining board prior to July 29, 1979, on a prorated basis covering the period from July 29, 1979, to the expiration date of the certificate of registration.
