CHAPTER 91, Laws of 1979

AN ACT to amend 945.01 (3) of the statutes, relating to exempting amusement devices which grant nonredeemable free replays from criminal gambling prohibitions.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 945.01 (3) of the statutes is amended to read:

945.01 (3) GAMBLING MACHINE. A gambling machine is a contrivance which for a consideration affords the player an opportunity to obtain something of value, the award of which is determined by chance, even though accompanied by some skill and whether or not the prize is automatically paid by the machine. "Gambling machine" does not include any device used in conducting a bingo occasion or raffle event under ch. 163 or any amusement device if it rewards the player exclusively with one or more nonredeemable free replays for achieving certain scores and does not change the ratio or record the number of the free replays so awarded.
