CHAPTER 110. Laws of 1981

AN ACT relating to including social security, supplemental security income and veterans pensions and disability payments in income for purposes of computing the homestead credit and farmland preservation credit, and for income computation purposes under the property tax deferral program.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- SECTION 1. Homestead and farmland preservation credit claims and property tax deferral program. (1) For 1981 homestead credit and farmland preservation credit claims filed in 1982, social security, supplemental security income and veterans pensions and disability recipients who received their January 1982 checks in December 1981 shall consider this check as January 1982 income for income computation purposes under section 71.09 (7) (a) 1 and (11) (a) 6. a of the statutes.
- (2) For 1982 homestead credit and farmland preservation credit claims filed in 1983, and for income computation under section 77.65 (5) of the statutes, social security, supplemental security income and veterans pensions and disability recipients shall include the amount of the January 1982 social security, supplemental security income and veterans pensions or disability check received in December 1981 as 1982 income for income computation purposes.
- (3) The department of revenue shall immediately advise 1981 homestead and farmland preservation claimants of these changes, and shall advise recipients who have already filed that they may submit amended homestead and farmland preservation credit claims for 1981 if they are affected by these provisions:
