1981 Senate Bill 11

CHAPTER 131, Laws of 1981

AN ACT to create 20.370 (4) (mv) and 23.20 of the statutes, relating to the use of department of natural resources' gravel pits and similar facilities and creating an appropriation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 20.370 (4) (mv) of the statutes is created to read:

20.370 (4) (mv) Use of department gravel pits. All moneys received from fees under s. 23.20 to pay any costs associated with allowing towns and counties to obtain gravel, sand, fill dirt or other fill material from any department-owned gravel pit or similar facility.

SECTION 2. 23.20 of the statutes is created to read:

23.20 Use of department gravel pits. The department may permit any town or county to obtain gravel, sand, fill dirt or other fill material needed for road purposes from any department-owned gravel pit or similar facility if this material is unavailable from private vendors within a reasonable distance of the worksite. The department may require environmental safeguards before permitting a town or county to obtain this material. The department shall charge a fee for this material commensurate with the fee charged by private vendors.
