AN ACT to create 970.02 (7) of the statutes, relating to obtaining criminal identification data.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

CHAPTER 144 944

SECTION 2. 970.02 (7) of the statutes is created to read:

970.02 (7) If the offense charged is one specified under s. 165.83 (2) (a), the judge shall determine if the defendant's fingerprints, photographs and other identifying data have been taken and, if not, the judge shall direct that this information be obtained.
