CHAPTER 147, Laws of 1981

AN ACT to create 972.11 (3) of the statutes, relating to release of exhibits or evidence in criminal actions and proceedings.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 972.11 (3) of the statutes is created to read:

- 972.11 (3) Upon the motion of any party or its own motion, a court may order that any exhibit or evidence be delivered to the party or the owner prior to the final determination of the action or proceeding if all of the following requirements are met:
 - (a) There is a written stipulation by all the parties agreeing to the order.
 - (b) No party will be prejudiced by the order.
- (c) A complete photographic or other record is made of any exhibits or evidence so released.
