## CHAPTER 153, Laws of 1981

AN ACT to amend 230.12 (1) (c) 2 and (6) of the statutes, relating to the compensation plan for nonrepresented classified state employes.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 230.12 (1) (c) 2 and (6) of the statutes are amended to read:

953 CHAPTER 153

230.12 (1) (c) 2. The secretary may establish a plan of extra compensation for work performed during selected hours at an hourly rate or rates subject to approval of the joint committee on employment relations. Eligibility for such extra compensation shall be as provided in the rules of the secretary compensation plan.

- (6) ADDITIONAL HOURS OF WORK PROVISIONS. Provisions relating to compensation for hours of work in addition to the standard basis of employment under s. 230.35 (5) (a) shall be provided for in the rules of the secretary. Employes shall be compensated in cash or time off for additional hours of work at the rate of 1.5 times the regular rate, except as exempted by the standards established under the rules of the secretary compensation plan. The provisions shall include the rate or rates to be paid to employes and the standards for determining which employes receive such compensation.
- SECTION 2. Effective date. The treatment of section 230.12 (1) (c) 2 and (6) of the statutes by this act takes effect on the effective date of the compensation plan which first contains the provisions under section 230.12 (1) (c) 2 and (6) of the statutes, as affected by this act or on the day following publication, whichever is later.
