CHAPTER 173, Laws of 1981

AN ACT to amend 13.83 (3) (title), (a) and (d) of the statutes, relating to the legislative council's native American study committee.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 13.83 (3) (title), (a) and (d) of the statutes are amended to read:

13.83 (3) (title) AMERICAN INDIAN STUDY COMMITTEE. (a) The council shall in each biennium create a native an American Indian study committee to study the problems and develop specific recommendations and legislative proposals relating to native Americans American Indians and the various Indian tribes in this state.

(d) The committee shall study the problems of native Americans <u>American Indians</u> and Indian tribes in this state in such fields as taxation, public welfare, education, highways and law enforcement.
