1981 Senate Bill 521

CHAPTER 179, Laws of 1981

AN ACT to renumber and amend 196.635; and to create 196.635 (1) and (3) of the statutes, relating to customer liability for unbilled utility service.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 196.635 of the statutes is renumbered 196.635 (intro.) and amended to read:

196.635 Unbilled utility service. (intro.) All residential service supplied by a public utility must be billed within 2 years of such service. No customer shall be liable for unbilled residential service 2 years after the date of such the service unless the customer obtained the service through fraud or deception.:

SECTION 2. 196.635 (1) and (3) of the statutes are created to read:

- 196.635 (1) The utility made a reasonable effort to measure the service, but the customer did not allow the utility access to any device, including but not limited to a meter, necessary to measure service.
- (3) The customer obtained the service by fraud or deception, including but not limited to theft or tampering with any device, including but not limited to a meter, necessary to measure service.
