CHAPTER 188, Laws of 1981

AN ACT to renumber and amend 341.267 (1); and to create 341.267 (1) (a) 1 and 2, (b) and (c) of the statutes, relating to motor vehicles used by public or nonpublic schools for driver's education and creating a penalty.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 341.267 (1) of the statutes is renumbered 341.267 (1) (a) (intro.) and amended to read:

341.267 (1) (a) (intro.) An annual <u>A</u> fee of \$3 shall be paid to the department for the <u>annual</u> registration of any motor vehicle loaned to for each of the following motor vehicles when used by a public or nonpublic school having an approved driver education program as certified by the department of public instruction or the board of vocational, technical and adult education. The motor vehicle shall be used for the exclusive purpose of behind-the-wheel instruction and such other operation as is necessary for maintenance and storage.

SECTION 2. 341.267 (1) (a) 1 and 2, (b) and (c) of the statutes are created to read:

341.267 (1) (a) 1. Any motor vehicle loaned to the school by a licensed motor vehicle dealer which is used for the exclusive purpose of behind-the-wheel instruction or for necessary maintenance and storage.

2. Any motor vehicle owned or leased by the school which is used for behind-the-wheel instruction.

(b) The department of public instruction shall establish uniform marking standards for a motor vehicle which is used as a driver education vehicle. The markings shall be removed when the owned or leased vehicle is being operated for other than behind-thewheel instruction or necessary maintenance and storage.

(c) Any person who makes a false statement in an application for registration under this subsection or who uses a motor vehicle which is registered under this subsection except as authorized under this subsection may be required to forfeit not more than \$200.

SECTION 3. Program responsibility changes. In the sections of the statutes listed in Column A, the program responsibilities references shown in Column B are deleted and the program responsibilities references shown in Column C are inserted:
