CHAPTER 196, Laws of 1981

AN ACT to amend 60.44 and 60.48; and to create 60.491 of the statutes, relating to appointment of a deputy town clerk and deputy town treasurer.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 60.44 of the statutes is amended to read:

60.44 Deputy; duties. Each town clerk may appoint a <u>deputy one or more deputies</u> for whom <u>he the town clerk</u> shall be responsible, who. A <u>deputy</u> shall take and file the official oath, and in. In case of the absence, sickness or other disability of the clerk, a <u>deputy</u> shall perform <u>his the clerk's</u> duties and receive the same compensation unless the town board shall appoint appoints a person to act as clerk.

SECTION 1m. 60.48 of the statutes is amended to read:

60.48 Town treasurer's bond. Every town treasurer and every deputy of a town treasurer shall execute and file an official bond which may be furnished by a surety company under s. 632.17 (2) in a sum to be fixed at not less than the whole amount of money estimated to come into his hands during his term, except in towns where the town board is

authorized to exercise village powers the amount of such bond shall be set by the town board.

SECTION 2. 60.491 of the statutes is created to read:

60.491 Deputy; duties. Each town treasurer may appoint a deputy for whom the treasurer shall be responsible. The deputy shall take and file the official oath. In case of the absence, sickness or other disability of the treasurer, the deputy shall perform the treasurer's duties and receive the same compensation unless the town board appoints a person to act as treasurer.
