CHAPTER 223, Laws of 1981

AN ACT to create 118.22 (4) and 118.23 (5) of the statutes, relating to the modification of provisions pertaining to renewal of teacher contracts and teacher tenure by collective bargaining agreements.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 118.22 (4) of the statutes is created to read:

118.22 (4) A collective bargaining agreement may modify, waive or replace any of the provisions of this section as they apply to teachers in the collective bargaining unit, but neither the employer nor the bargaining agent for the employes is required to bargain such modification, waiver or replacement.

SECTION 2. 118.23 (5) of the statutes is created to read:

118.23 (5) A collective bargaining agreement may modify, waive or replace any of the provisions of this section as they apply to teachers in the collective bargaining unit, but neither the employer nor the bargaining agent for the employes is required to bargain such modification, waiver or replacement.
