CHAPTER 232, Laws of 1981

AN ACT to renumber 66.431 (5) (a) 5; and to create 66.40 (9) (v) and 66.431 (5) (a) 5 of the statutes, relating to preservation of records by city housing and redevelopment authorities.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 66.40 (9) (v) of the statutes is created to read:

66.40 (9) (v) To establish a procedure for preservation of the records of the authority by the use of microfilm or another reproductive device. Any such procedure shall assure that copies of such records that are open to public inspection continue to be available to members of the public requesting them. A photographic reproduction is deemed the same as an original record for all purposes if it meets the applicable standards established in s. 16.61 (7).

SECTION 2. 66.431 (5) (a) 5 of the statutes is renumbered 66.431 (5) (a) 8.

SECTION 3. 66.431 (5) (a) 5 of the statutes is created to read:

66.431 (5) (a) 5. To establish a procedure for preservation of the records of the authority by the use of microfilm or another reproductive device. Any such procedure shall assure that copies of such records that are open to public inspection continue to be available to members of the public requesting them. A photographic reproduction is deemed
