CHAPTER 24, Laws of 1981

AN ACT to amend 15.197 (11n) (intro.) and (d) (intro.) of the statutes, relating to revising the membership of the state council on developmental disabilities.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 15.197 (11n) (intro.) and (d) (intro.) of the statutes are amended to read:

15.197 (11n) (intro.) There is created a council on developmental disabilities. Section 15.03 applies to the council's attachment to the department of health and social services. Members shall be <u>state residents and shall be</u> appointed in the following manner for staggered 4-year terms:

(d) (intro.) At least one-third one-half of the membership shall consist of persons with developmental disabilities, or their parents or guardians, who are not officers of or of immediate relatives or guardians of persons with mentally impairing developmental disabilities. These members may not manage, own or have a controlling interest in any entity, or be employes of any state agency or of any other entity, which receives funds or provides services under federal developmental disabilities funds or provides services using federal formula developmental disabilities funds. These members shall be appointed by the governor, with consideration given to:
