CHAPTER 258, Laws of 1981

AN ACT to repeal 47.02 of the statutes, relating to farms at schools for the visually handicapped and deaf (suggested as remedial legislation by the department of health and social services).

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

LAW REVISION COMMITTEE PREFATORY NOTE: This bill is a remedial legislation proposal, requested by the department of health and social services, and introduced by the law revision committee under s. 13.83 (1) (c) 4 of the statutes. After careful consideration of the various provisions of this bill, the law revision committee has determined that this bill makes remedial changes in the statutes, and that these changes are desirable to maintain the accuracy and usefulness of the statutes.

SECTION 1. 47.02 of the statutes is repealed.

Note: Current s. 47.02 of the statutes requires the department of health and social services to administer the farms connected with the Wisconsin school for the visually handicapped and the Wisconsin school for the deaf. This bill repeals section 47.02 of the statutes because the farms no longer exist and the schools for the visually handicapped and the deaf are now administered by the department of public instruction.
