## CHAPTER 26, Laws of 1981

AN ACT to repeal 230.03 (12) (a) and (b); to renumber 230.03 (11m); to renumber and amend 230.03 (12) (c) and (d); to amend 230.03 (12) (intro.), 230.14 (2) and 230.16 (2); and to create 230.26 (1m) and 230.27 (1m) of the statutes, relating to residency requirements for state employes in the classified service.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 230.03 (11m) of the statutes is renumbered 230.03 (13).

SECTION 2. 230.03 (12) (intro.) of the statutes is amended to read:

230.03 (12) (intro.) "Wisconsin resident Resident of this state" means a person who:

SECTION 3. 230.03 (12) (a) and (b) of the statutes are repealed.

SECTION 4. 230.03 (12) (c) and (d) of the statutes are renumbered 230.03 (12) (a) and (b) and amended to read:

230.03 (12) (a) Has resided within the state for a total of 5 years not less than 10 days; or

(b) Is the spouse of a person meeting the requirements of par. (a), (b) or (c).

SECTION 5. 230.14 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

230.14 (2) The administrator may recruit outside of this state only if the administrator determines that there is a critical shortage in this state of persons of residents of this state possessing the skills or qualifications required for the position.

SECTION 6. 230.16 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

230.16 (2) Competitive examinations shall be free and open to all applicants who at the time of application are residents of this state and who have fulfilled the preliminary requirements stated in the examination announcement. To assure that all state residents of this state have a fair opportunity to compete, examinations shall be held at such times and places as, in the judgment of the administrator, most nearly meet the convenience of applicants and needs of the service. If a critical need for employes in specific classifications or positions exists, the administrator may open competitive examinations to persons who are not residents of other states this state.

SECTION 7. 230.26 (1m) of the statutes is created to read:

230.26 (1m) No appointing authority may appoint a person who is not a resident of this state to a limited term appointment.

SECTION 8. 230,27 (1m) of the statutes is created to read:

230.27 (1m) No appointing authority may appoint a person who is not a resident of this state to a project position under this section.
