CHAPTER 277, Laws of 1981

AN ACT to amend 348.08 (2) of the statutes, relating to eliminating the flagging requirement for trains of agricultural vehicles crossing highway intersections.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 348.08 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

348.08 (2) Whenever any train of agricultural vehicles is being operated under authority of sub. (1) (b) is about to cross an intersection with a through highway, the operator of the train shall cause the intersection to be flagged at points on the through highway approximately 125 feet in each direction from the place of crossing. Such trains of agricultural vehicles the train shall be equipped as provided in s. 347.21 and. The trailer hitches of the train shall be of a positive nature so as to prevent accidental release.
