CHAPTER 300, Laws of 1981

AN ACT to amend 799.11 (1) (b); and to create 704.22 and 799.11 (1) (g) of the statutes, relating to service of process and venue in a residential tenancy.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 704.22 of the statutes is created to read:

- 704.22 Service of process in residential tenancy on nonresident party. (1) A party to a residential tenancy in this state who is not a resident of this state shall designate an agent to accept service of process in this state for an action involving the tenancy. The agent shall be a resident of this state or a corporation authorized to do business in this state. If a party is a corporation, the agent is the corporation's registered agent.
- (2) Designation of an agent under sub. (1) shall be in writing and filed with the secretary of state.

SECTION 2. 799.11 (1) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

799.11 (1) (b) In contract actions <u>not involving a residential tenancy</u>, the county where the defendant resides or is personally served.

SECTION 3. 799.11 (1) (g) of the statutes is created to read:

799.11 (1) (g) In a contract action involving a residential tenancy, the county where the premises are located or where all parties reside.

SECTION 4. Program responsibilities. In the list of program responsibilities for the secretary of state under section 14.361 of the statutes, reference to section "704.22" is inserted.
