CHAPTER 304, Laws of 1981

AN ACT to create 632.75 (4) of the statutes, relating to disability insurance policy coverage of health care services provided outside this state.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 632.75 (4) of the statutes is created to read:

632.75 (4) OUT-OF-STATE SERVICE PROVIDERS. Except as provided in s. 632.86, no disability insurance policy may exclude or limit coverage of health care services provided outside this state, if the services are provided within 75 miles of the insured's residence in a facility licensed or approved by the state where the facility is located.

SECTION 2. Initial applicability. This act first applies to disability insurance policies issued or renewed on or after the effective date of this act.
