CHAPTER 310, Laws of 1981

AN ACT to repeal and recreate 940.225 (6) of the statutes, relating to spousal sexual assault.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

PREFATORY NOTE: This proposal repeals the spousal exception to the sexual assault law and creates a provision intended to negate any presumption that a person is incapable of committing sexual assault because of marriage to the victim.

SECTION 1. 940.225 (6) of the statutes is repealed and recreated to read:

940.225 (6) MARRIAGE NOT A BAR TO PROSECUTION. A defendant shall not be presumed to be incapable of violating this section because of marriage to the complainant.
