AN ACT relating to consent adoptions.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Nonstatutory provisions; consent adoptions. Notwithstanding section 48.90 (3) of the statutes, as created by chapter 81, laws of 1981, in any case where a child has been placed for adoption with the consent of his or her parent or parents before February 1, 1982, under sections 48.84 (1) (a) and 48.87, 1979 stats., the person or persons with whom the child was placed may file a petition to adopt the child under section 48.90 of the statutes, as affected by chapter 81, laws of 1981, without complying with sections 48.835 (3), 48.837, 48.88 and 48.91 (2) (b) of the statutes, as affected by chapter 81, laws of 1981. The law in effect at the time the consents were obtained applies to those adoption proceedings where a child has been placed for adoption with the consent of his or her parent or parents before February 1, 1982. This SECTION does not apply after December 31, 1982.
