## CHAPTER 342, Laws of 1981

AN ACT to create 196.03 (5) of the statutes, relating to electric utility rates for certain purposes.

## CHAPTER 342

1420

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 196.03 (5) of the statutes is created to read:

196.03 (5) (a) In this subsection "facility" means nuclear-fired electric generating equipment and associated facilities subject to a loss of coolant accident in March 1979.

(b) The commission may not authorize a utility furnishing electricity to recover in rates charged to consumers for the costs of repairing, maintaining or operating any facility owned by another public utility located outside of this state.

(c) The commission may not authorize a utility furnishing electricity to recover in rates charged to consumers for insurance premiums that provide coverage for an accident at a facility in March 1979, if the coverage is first obtained on or after the effective date of this subsection (1981).

(d) No utility may otherwise pay directly or indirectly for the costs in pars. (b) and (c).
