CHAPTER 370, Laws of 1981

AN ACT to amend 779.18 (1) of the statutes, relating to log liens.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 779.18 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

779.18 (1) Any person who shall, personally or by a beast or machine or vehicle, perform performs any services in cutting, hauling, running, felling, piling, driving, rafting, booming, cribbing, towing, sawing, peeling, kiln drying or manufacturing logs, timber, stave bolts, heading staves, pulp wood, cordwood, firewood, railroad ties, piling, telegraph poles, telephone poles, fence posts, paving timber, tan or other barks or in preparing wood for or manufacturing charcoal shall have a lien upon such the material for the amount owing for such the services, which shall take precedence of all other claims, liens or encumbrances thereon or sales thereof.
