CHAPTER 387, Laws of 1981

AN ACT to amend 46.05 (1n) of the statutes, relating to a prison site for a medium security institution.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 46.05 (1n) of the statutes, as created by chapter 20, laws of 1981, is amended to read:

46.05 (1n) In addition to the institutions under sub. (1), the department shall establish a medium security institution which is located at 819 North 6th street at the site which, on July 31, 1981, constitutes floors of the state office building 929 North 6th street in Milwaukee, at the site which on the effective date of this act (1981), is occupied by the university of Wisconsin-extension division. The building commission may negotiate a settlement with the university of Wisconsin system to compensate it for displacement from and equity in the university of Wisconsin-extension division properties. The department may propose alternative sites in Milwaukee county to the site specified in this subsection. The building commission may direct the department to prepare an environmental impact statement under s. 1.11 regarding any proposed alternative site. The site specified in this subsection applies unless revised by act of the legislature.
