CHAPTER 75, Laws of 1981

AN ACT to authorize and direct expenditure of \$5,000 from moneys appropriated to the department of natural resources for payment of a claim against the state made by Donald Wirth.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Claim against the state. There is authorized and directed to be expended from the appropriation under section 20.370 (1) (mu) of the statutes (fish management), as affected by the laws of 1981, \$5,000 in payment of a claim against the state by Donald Wirth, Cross Plains, Wisconsin, to compensate him for past and future medical expenses and pain and suffering incurred as the result of an accident which occurred at Salmo Pond in the Black Earth Creek Fishery in Dane county on April 29, 1976. The claimant struck an unmarked cable while riding his power-driven cycle down a roadway at the pond. The cable was placed by employes of the department of natural resources. Acceptance of this payment operates as a full and complete release to the state and its officers and employes for all expenses and damages incurred by the claimant as a result of this accident.
