1983 Wisconsin Act 139

AN ACT to ratify a supplemental agreement negotiated between the state of Wisconsin and the Wisconsin State Employes Union, AFSCME Council 24, and its appropriate affiliated locals, AFL-CIO, for the remainder of the 1983-85 biennium, covering employes in the clerical and related collective bargaining unit.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Supplemental agreement ratified. Notwithstanding section 111.92 of the statutes, the legislature ratifies the supplemental agreement dated December 20, 1983, negotiated for the remainder of the 1983-85 biennium between the state of Wisconsin, department of employment relations, and the Wisconsin State Employes Union, AFSCME Council 24, and its appropriate affiliated locals, AFL-CIO, covering employes in the clerical and related collective bargaining unit under subchapter V of chapter 111 of the statutes, as approved by the employes of the clerical and related collective bargaining unit and approved and recommended by the joint committee on employment relations. The secretary of employment relations shall file an official copy of the supplemental agreement, certified by the cochairpersons of the joint committee on employment relations, with the secretary of state. No formal or informal agreement between the parties which is not a part of the official copy of the supplemental agreement is deemed to be approved by the legislature under this act.
