1983 Wisconsin Act 214

- AN ACT to amend 43.54 (1) (a) of the statutes, relating to membership of a library board in a school district authorized to maintain public library facilities.
- The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 43.54 (1) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

43.54(1) (a) Each public library established under s. 43.52 shall be administered by a library board composed in each city of the 2nd or 3rd class of 9 members, in each city of the 4th class or county of 7 members and in each village, town, tribal government or tribal association of 5 members. Members shall be residents of the municipality, except that not more than 2 members may be residents of towns adjacent to the municipality.

Members shall be appointed by the mayor, county board chairman, village president, town chairman or tribal chairman, respectively, with the approval of the municipal governing body. In school districts authorized to maintain public library facilities under s. 43.52, the library board shall be composed of 7.9 members appointed by the school board chairperson with the approval of the school board.
