1983 Wisconsin Act 250

AN ACT to amend 125.51 (4) (a) 2 and (b) 1 of the statutes, relating to intoxicating liquor license quotas.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 125.51 (4) (a) 2 and (b) 1 of the statutes are amended to read:

125.51 (4) (a) 2. "Population" means the number of inhabitants determined by the last decennial federal census or special census conducted under contract with the U.S. bureau of the census, or, in the case of newly incorporated cities or villages, determined under s. 66.013 (2) (b), less, in either case, inmates of charitable, mental and penal institutions in the municipality.

(b) 1. One license per 500 population or fraction thereof. A municipality's population, for purposes of determining its quota, may be adjusted on the basis of a special census only once during the period between decennial censuses.
