1983 Wisconsin Act 343

AN ACT to repeal 349.18 (intro.); and to amend 349.18 (title), 349.18 (1) and 349.18 (2) of the statutes, relating to authorizing regulation and registration of bicycles by towns.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 349.18 (title) of the statutes is amended to read:

349.18 (title) Additional traffic-control authority of cities, towns and villages.

SECTION 2. 349.18 (intro.) of the statutes is repealed.

SECTION 3. 349.18 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

349.18 (1) Designate Any city or village may by ordinance designate the number of persons that may ride on a power driven cycle or motor bicycle at any one time and the highways upon which a power driven cycle, motor bicycle or moped may or may not be operated;

SECTION 4. 349.18 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

349.18 (2) Regulate Any city, town or village may by ordinance regulate the operation of bicycles and require their registration, including the payment of a registration fee.
