## 1983 Wisconsin Act

AN ACT to amend 98.12 (2) of the statutes, relating to ice cream container capacity.
The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows.
SECTION 1. 98.12 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:
98.12 (2) Ice cream, ice milk, water ices or other frozen desserts of a similar nature packaged prior to sale may be sold by liquid measure only and shall be packaged only in containers with capacities of one-half liquid pint, one liquid pint, one liquid quart, enehalf gallon, one gallen, 5 quarts, $21 / 2$ gallens, $31 / 2$ gallens or a multiple of one gallen liquid quart. This section does not apply if such products are packaged at time of sale at retail or sold in quantities of less than one-half liquid pint.
