1983 Wisconsin Act 404

AN ACT to amend 49.046 (2) (a) and 49.047 (4) of the statutes, relating to eligibility for relief to needy Indian persons.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 49.046 (2) (a) of the statutes, as created by 1983 Wisconsin Act 27, is amended to read:

49.046 (2) (a) The person is an American Indian residing on tax-free land or is the spouse or child of such a person residing in the same household, except that no student, other than a student enrolled in a public or private primary or secondary educational institution is eligible for aid under this section.

SECTION 2. 49.047 (4) of the statutes is amended to read:

83 WisAct 404 - 1722 -

49.047 (4) Recipients of relief under s. 49.046 shall participate in a work experience program. Nonparticipation shall be cause for terminating assistance. The department, after consultation with all elected tribal governing bodies, shall by rule provide exceptions to this policy, but the department may not exempt individuals from participation in the work experience program because of their status as students.
