1983 Wisconsin Act 458

AN ACT to renumber and amend 104.01 (2); and to create 104.01 (2) (b) 2 of the statutes, relating to exempting certain real estate agents and salespersons from the coverage of the state minimum wage laws.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 104.01 (2) of the statutes is renumbered 104.01 (2) (a) and amended to read:

104.01 (2) (a) "Employe" means every person <u>individual</u> who is in receipt of or is entitled to any compensation for labor performed for any employer. This chapter does not apply to any employe

(b) "Employe" does not mean:

<u>1. Any individual</u> engaged in the house to house delivery of newspapers to the consumer or engaged in direct retail sale to the consumer.

SECTION 2. 104.01 (2) (b) 2 of the statutes is created to read:

104.01 (2) (b) 2. Any individual engaged in performing services for a person as a real estate agent or as a real estate salesperson, if all of those services are performed for remuneration solely by commission.

SECTION 3. Initial applicability. This act applies to the payment of wages due for services performed on or after the effective date of this act.
