1983 Wisconsin Act 65

AN ACT to amend 125.08 (2) (b) of the statutes, relating to photographs on official identification cards.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 125.08 (2) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

125.08 (2) (b) Processing. Prior to issuing an identification card to an applicant, the issuing officer shall require that a black and white photograph of the applicant be affixed to the form and that the form be signed by the applicant and the issuing officer. The issuing officer shall send the completed form to the department of administration for processing of the identification card and the department of administration shall return it to the issuing officer for issuance to the applicant. The department of administration shall charge the issuing officer for its costs under this paragraph.
