1983 Wisconsin Act 70

AN ACT to amend 145.10 (2) of the statutes, relating to suspension of a plumber's or utility contractor's license by the department of industry, labor and human relations.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 145.10 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

145.10 (2) A copy of the complaint with notice of the suspension of license or permit shall be served on the person complained against, and the person's answer to the complaint shall be filed with the department and the complainant within 10 days after service. The department shall thereupon set the matter for hearing as promptly as possible and within 30 days after the date of filing the complaint. Either party may appear at the hearing in person or by attorney or agent. The department shall make its findings and determination within 90 days after the date that the hearing is concluded and send a copy to each interested party.
