1985 Wisconsin Act 102

AN ACT to amend 752.31 (2) (c) of the statutes, relating to appeals in habitual traffic offender cases.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 752.31 (2) (c) of the statutes is amended to read:

752.31 (2) (c) Cases involving violations of traffic regulations, as defined in s. 345.20 (1) (b), or nonmov-

ing traffic violations, as defined in s. 345.28 (1), and cases under s. 343.305 and ch. 351.

NOTE: Subsection (2) (c) is amended to clarify that appeals in habitual traffic offender cases may be decided by one court of appeals judge.
