## 1985 Wisconsin Act 11

AN ACT to repeal and recreate 40.63 (8) (f) of the statutes, relating to the effective date of disability annuities.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 40.63 (8) (f) of the statutes is repealed and recreated to read:

40.63 (8) (f) If an employer certifies that an employe's date of termination of employment is being extended past the last day worked due to any payment for accumulated sick leave, vacation or compensatory time, a participating employe may file an application for a disability annuity as if the last day worked were

the last day paid. Regardless of the application date for a disability annuity, the date of termination of employment for effective date purposes shall be deemed to be the last day for which the participant was paid, including any payment for accumulated leave, but if a disability annuity applicant whose application has been approved dies before the last day paid, but after the last day worked, the effective date is the date of death.
