1985 Wisconsin Act 122

AN ACT to authorize and direct expenditure of \$7,900.44 from moneys appropriated to the department of health and social services for payment of a claim against the state made by Hy Dorosin.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Claim against the state. There is authorized and directed to be expended from the appropriation under section 20.435 (2) (gk) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of 1983, \$7,900.44 in payment of a claim against the state made by Hy Dorosin, Chicago, Illinois, to compensate him for the value of

diapers provided in 1982 to the department of health and social services at the southern center for the developmentally disabled, plus handling, freight and interest charges. Acceptance of this payment operates as a full and complete release to the state for any claim resulting from the claimant's supply of diapers to the department in 1982.
