## 1985 Wisconsin Act 140

AN ACT to amend 32.035 (4) (a) of the statutes, relating to exempting certain projects from the agricultural impact statement requirements.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 32.035 (4) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

32.035 (4) (a) When an impact statement is required; permitted. The department shall prepare an agricultural impact statement for each project, except a project under ch. 81 or a project located entirely within the boundaries of a city or village, if the project involves the actual or potential exercise of the powers of eminent domain and if any interest in more than 5 acres of any farm operation may be taken. The

department may prepare an agricultural impact statement on a project if located entirely within the boundaries of a city or village or involving any interest in 5 or less fewer acres of any farm operation may be taken and if the condemnation will would have a significant effect on any farm operation as a whole.

SECTION 2. Initial applicability. The treatment of section 32.035 (4) (a) of the statutes by this act first applies to projects for which the condemnor has not given notice to the department of agriculture, trade and consumer protection under section 32.035 (3) of the statutes prior to the effective date of this SECTION.
