1985 Wisconsin Act 155

AN ACT to create 29.101 of the statutes, relating to the use of lead and other types of shotshells for hunting waterfowl and coots.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 29.101 of the statutes is created to read:

29.101 Lead shotshell restrictions. No person may hunt waterfowl or coots with any firearm utilizing lead shotshell or any other shotshell classified by the federal government as toxic or harmful to wildlife or the environment.

SECTION 1m. Nonstatutory provisions. The department of natural resources shall develop and

issue an educational pamphlet on steel shotshell to be distributed during 1986 and 1987 to persons issued waterfowl hunting stamps under section 29.102 of the statutes.

SECTION 2. Effective dates. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2), this act takes effect on the day following publication.

(2) The treatment of section 29.101 of the statutes takes effect on September 1, 1987.
